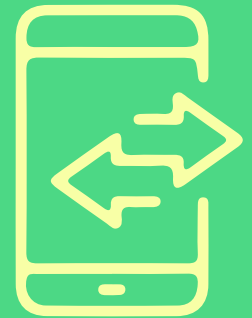


Go Paperless

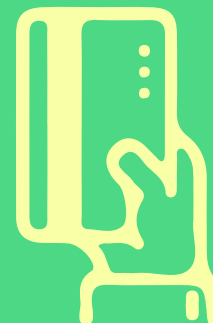


Shred Your Old Paperwork

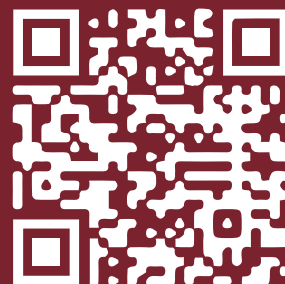
