

Important Changes at Your Credit Union!

Fire Police City County FCU is committed to providing you with the best service and financial tools possible and we've worked hard to deliver that promise. We've listened to your requests for modern banking technology and have begun the process of a complete system upgrade.

Advances made in banking technology have increased the demand for electronic services. The ease of banking without the need to drive to a branch has become so common among our members that we have seen a significant reduction in the usage of some of our branches. With fewer members needing to come in to branches and because three of our locations are within close proximity of another office, we have decided to redirect these resources to better benefit all members.

Effective April 27, 2018, our branches located at Rousseau Centre, Citizens' Square and Inwood Drive will be closed. All employees working at these branches will assume roles at one of our other 6 locations. New state-of-the-art ATMs will be installed at the Rousseau Centre and Citizens' Square locations that will offer chip enabled technology and the ability to accept deposits. Members who use these branches can still bank in person at the following locations:

Our Main Office, located at 3306 N. Clinton Street, is less than 3 miles from both Rousseau Centre and Citizens' Square and just 4 miles from Inwood Drive

Our New Haven branch, located at 104 Lincoln Highway West, and our Maplecrest branch, located at 7505 Maplecrest Road, are both only 5 miles from Inwood Drive.

The decision to close branches is never an easy one. Fire Police City County FCU remains a sound and secure financial institution as it has been since 1933. We value your business and are dedicated to providing exceptional member service now and in the future.


REPORT OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Protected events include:

- Loss of life, cancels remaining loan balance as of date of death (up to \$75,000)
- Disability, cancels up to 12 payments per occurrence (aggregate max. of \$15,000, up to \$1,000/month)
- Involuntary unemployment, cancels up to 3 payments per occurrence (aggregate max. of \$15,000, up to \$1,000/month). Primary borrower only

Mechanical Breakdown Protection (MBP) is a surefire way to make sure that your vehicle is well taken care of and has the longest life expectancy. Dealers love to sell their extended warranties, which offer less value than the Credit Union's MBP program and typically costs hundreds of dollars more! Your MBP with the Credit Union is a smart way to cover the expense of mechanical failures. Should your vehicle experience a malfunction after the manufacturer's warranty expires without an extended warranty, you will have no protection from the unexpected repair costs that can be in the thousands of dollars.

Vehicles today are complex and contain high-tech sensors, electronics, and computers that frequently suffer unexpected failure and need to be replaced. While engines and transmissions are more reliable than ever, it's these other sophisticated parts that frequently fail.

As vehicles become more complex, associated repair costs rise dramatically!

Lastly, it's always a good idea to look into Guaranteed Asset Protection (GAP). GAP is a non-insurance product that covers the "gap" between your vehicle's value and the amount you still owe. If your vehicle is stolen or involved in a major accident, GAP may cover the difference between your primary carrier insurance settlement and the payoff on your loan. GAP comes with auto deductible reimbursement of up to \$500. In addition, GAP Advantage could pay an additional \$1,000 toward the purchase of a replacement vehicle when you finance the new vehicle through Fire Police City County FCU within 90 days of an adverse occurrence to your vehicle.
