Scammers are always finding new ways to get their hands on your personal information. One common ploy is the tech support scam. The scammer either calls you or sends a message to your computer telling you that a virus or other malware has been detected, often imitating big companies like Microsoft and Apple. The scammer then guides you through a way to "fix" your computer. In most cases, the scammers request for you to give them remote access, which lets them take control of your computer.

In both cases, the scammer either causes harm to your computer by downloading real malware, or goes through and finds your personal information. After all the damage has been done, the scammers often ask for a payment, trying to get your money and credit card numbers.

The internet can be a very scary and dangerous place. Follow these few steps to avoid such scams:

- Never answer phone calls from unknown numbers
- Never reply to pop-up messages while browsing the internet
- If you think something is wrong with your computer take it to a licensed repair shop

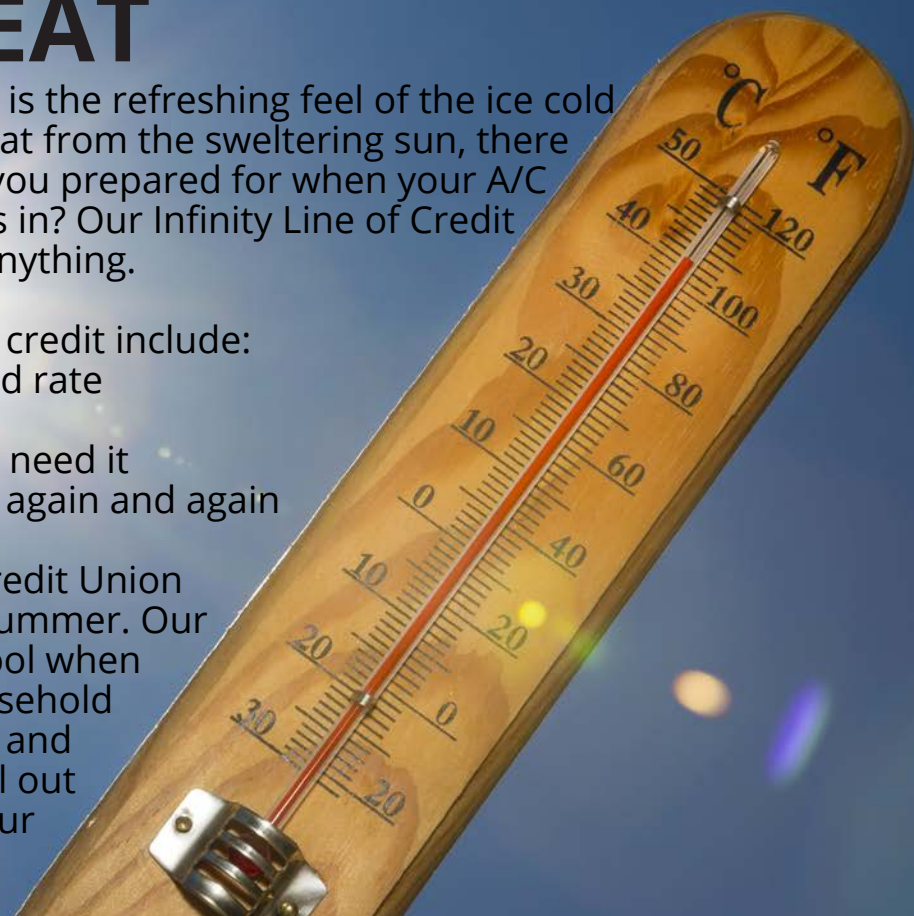

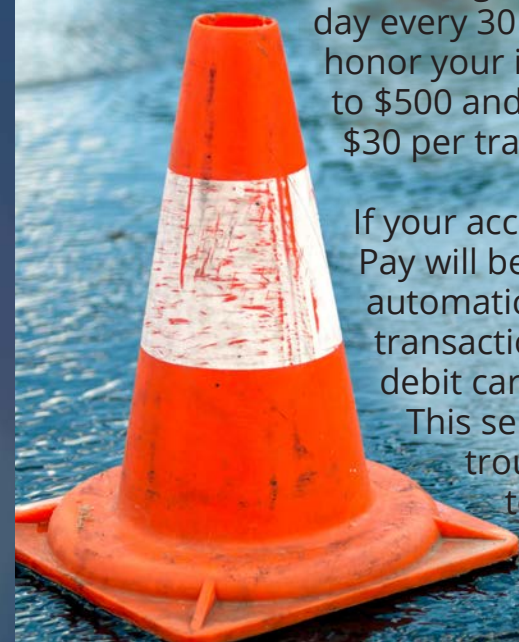


## PEACE OF MIND

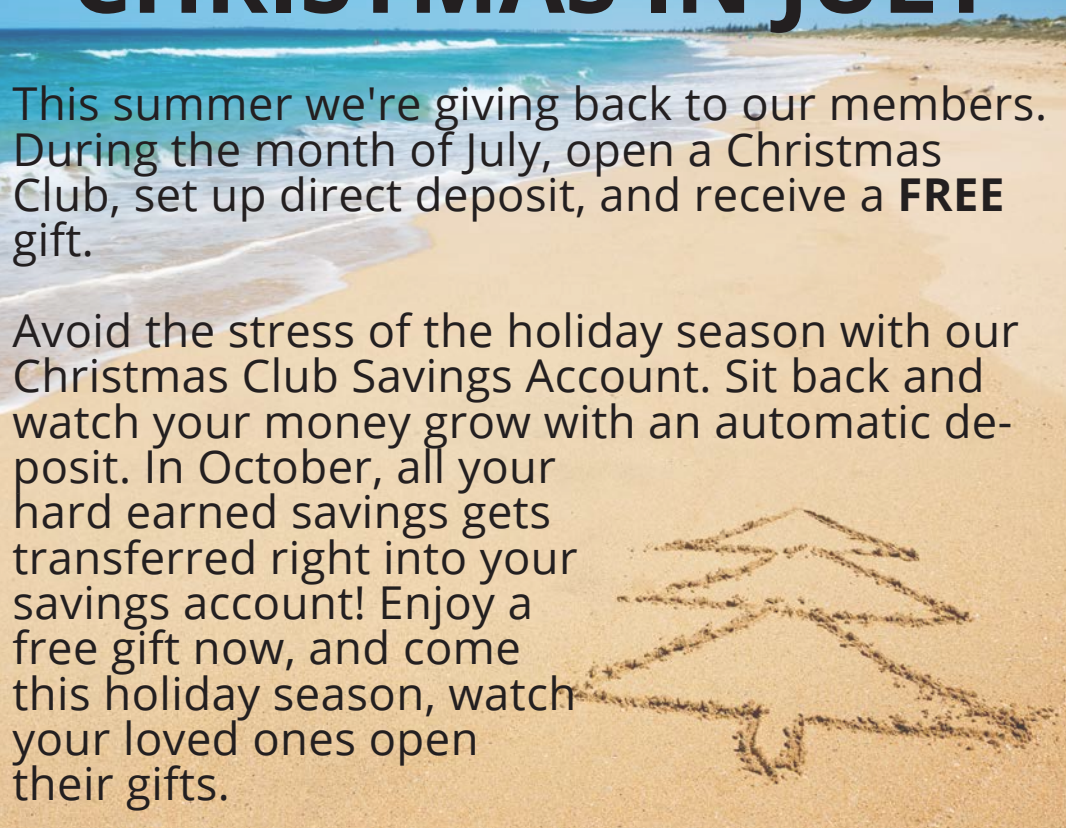
