WHAT IS PHISHING?

It's a cybercrime in which people are targeted by email, telephone, or text message by someone posing as a legitimate institution or person. The victim is asked to give personal information such as personally identifiable information, banking and credit card details, and passwords. The information is used to access important accounts and can result in identity theft and financial loss.



- Scammers will use attention-grabbing statements or lucrative offers such as winning the lottery. If it seems too good to be true, it probably is.
- Cybercriminals will create a sense of urgency with their messages. Sometimes they will say you have only a few minutes to update your information before your account is suspended. Most organizations will give you enough time before they terminate your account and won't ask for personal details over the Internet.
- Links in phishing messages can be fake. Hovering over a link will show you the actual URL where you will be directed. It can be similar to a real website, but it may include a misspelling.
- Attachments can hold things like ransomware and other viruses. If you weren't expecting it, don't open it.
- Messages from unknown or untrusted senders can be a red flag. If it seems out of the ordinary or out of character, don't click lt.
