Watch Out for USPS delivery information scams



Have you received a text message claiming there's an issue with a USPS delivery and asking you to click a link? If you didn't sign up for tracking updates, don't click—it's a scam!

This type of fraud, called smishing, involves deceptive text messages designed to steal personal and financial information. Scammers often disguise themselves as trusted organizations, like USPS or financial institutions, to appear legitimate. They attempt to collect sensitive details such as Social Security numbers, credit card information, and login credentials to commit fraud.

Stay Safe:

- USPS will never send unsolicited tracking texts with links.
- Do not click on suspicious links—



Clicking on fraudulent links, like the one shown above, can lead to identity theft, the installation of malware on your device, and could lead to your contact information being sold to people who are looking to take advantage of you.

- visit USPS.com directly to track packages.
- Report suspicious messages to the USPS and stay vigilant.

For a secure and convenient way to preview your incoming mail and track packages, you can sign up for USPS Informed Delivery. The free service provides: emails with images of your letter-sized mail; package tracking and management in one place; and a secure way to stay informed without clicking on potentially harmful links.
